All teams must have dark and light colored uniforms. These uniforms must at the very least have numbers on the back of the shirts. Shirts may be t-shirts. Please make sure that you include both sets of shirt numbers on your oster form.
A small admission fee per day will be: Adults \$3.00, Students \$1.00, Family \$6.00
Awards: All team players and coaches will receive a Tournament entrance Pass. This pass will allow participants of get both the boys tournament at the Y and the girls tournament at the elementary school.
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Game MVP - awards shall be presented after each game. (The officials for that specific game will select this MVP ward)
Team Sportsmanship Award- will be presented to the team exhibiting the utmost of team sportsmanship, which includes attitudes and actions of players, coaches, and team's fans. Please shake hands before and after each ame.
